Q Is it possible to make my eye-brows grow in faster if I've overplucked them?

A Yes, the trick is to coat on a lash-stimulating serum—it works on brows too, says New York dermatologist David Bank. You should see regrowth in about 30 days. Meanwhile, fill in patches with a pencil, and then coat on a clear brow gel to enhance your shape, says brow pro Anastasia Soare.

Q Is there a way to revive a tube of dried-out mascara?

A Yes, as long as it isn't older than three months (at that point, you'll need to toss it anyway to avoid bacteria). If it's not, place the tube under running hot water for a minute to soften up the product inside, says NYC makeup artist Jessica Liebeskind.

Make sure the cap is screwed on tightly to keep your mascara fresh.



A The skin in those areas is thicker, so it often gets dry and discolored. Seal in extra moisture daily with a lotion that has soy to lighten up deep spots naturally and add a glowy finish, says New Jersey dermatologist Jeanine Downie.
